

Changes made to the public data lists

We have made improvements to the public data lists. There are two new public lists and improved usability across all new and existing public lists.

1. The column view on Certificate Registry public list has been reordered

The column views on the Certificate Registry have been reordered to place the most relevant and used columns in immediate view.

The order of the column, from left to right, will now appear as follows:


1. Status

2. Static column header implemented on all public lists

To improve usability a change has been made to fix the header columns, so that when scrolling down the web page, the column headers will remain visible.



3. Ability to export public lists as a csv file type

The ability to export files as a csv file type has been made available in all the public lists,



Due to a system limitation, only 20,000 records can be exported at a time. Some tips for you to manage this:

- Firstly, identify whether the data you are trying to export is within the 20,000-record limit. Check the bottom of the table you are filtering to confirm this number:

- In the above example, the total number of records exceeds 20,000. You can split your exports by applying filters first. For example, split the information by timeframes (Date Registered from – Date Registered to). In this example I have decided to only export records for certificates registered from 1/05/2023 and 31/05/2023. This has reduced the number of records and I will be able to export all, based on that selection:

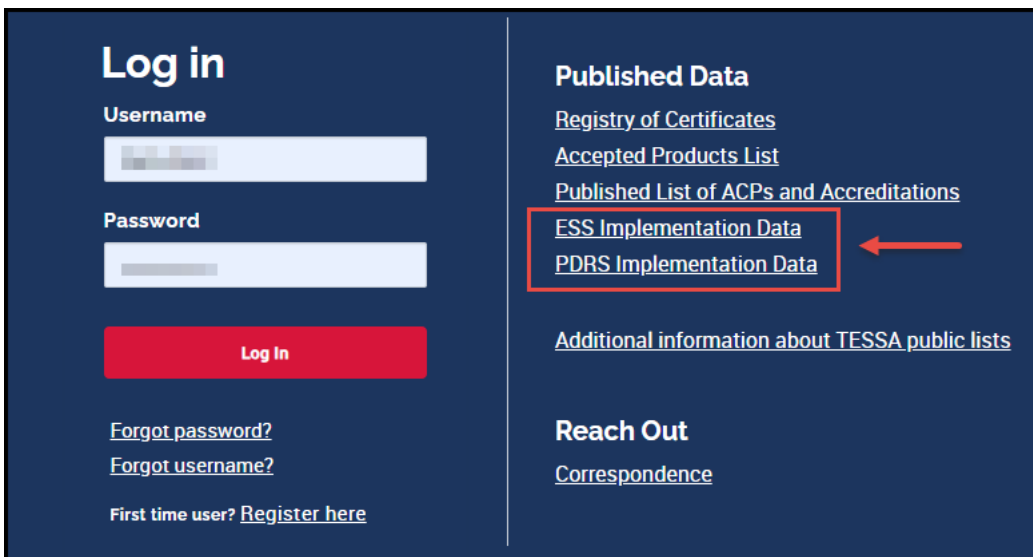
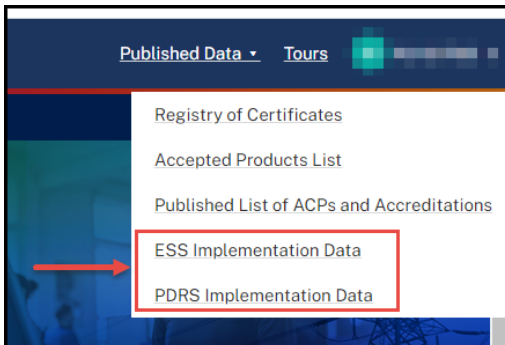
4. All public lists can now be accessed while logged in to your TESSA account

Logged in account holders will be able to access and use the public lists without needing to log out. When logged in, on the TESSA Home page a new menu option is now available in the top right-hand corner called **Published Data**



5. Two new public lists have been added, for ESS implementation data and PDRS implementation data

The two new implementation data lists can be accessed as a logged in account holder, through the new menu option on the account home page. Or as a member of the public from the external facing TESSA portal page.



6. New data has been added to some of the public data lists

A full activity definition description is now available in the value field next to the existing activity definition "code" (eg B1) on the Accreditation Features public list.

7. Export notification displayed to users when export exceeds 20,000 records

A new informational prompt will appear if the file to be exported from any of the public lists exceeds 20,000 records. The export can still occur; however, the export file will only contain 20,000 records.

ipartdev.service-now.com says
This list can't be exported all at once. Due to a system limitation only a maximum of 20,000 records can be exported at a time.
As such, if you proceed you will only receive a partial export. You can reduce the number of records to be exported by using the available filters.
It can take up to 2 minutes to download a large number of records.

8. Basic or Advanced filter options

New basic filtering options have been implemented on all the public data lists. Each of the public data lists now contain several search fields that can be used to conduct a quick basic filter search.

To use the basic filtering options, fill out one field or a combination of several different fields and then select the search button. Search results will automatically be returned and displayed in the data table directly below the search fields.

The search results from basic filtering option can be exported using the existing export feature, or a new basic filtering search can be undertaken by selecting the clear button.

If a more in-depth targeted search is required, the existing advanced filtering option is still available on all the public lists. When the advanced filter option is selected, the basic filtering options will disappear, then select the filter icon to access the advanced filters.
